"Monkey Monkey Music: The Videos" (Not rated, Monkey Monkey Music, \$19.99): Meredith LaVande, the "Renaissance woman of children's music," collects 15 videos based on songs, including "Jump High" and "Can You Paint a Rainbow," from her hit first album. "Sid & Marty Krofft's Saturday Morning Hits" (Not rated, Vivendi, \$14.93): It's a blast from the psychedelic past with this collection of episodes from some of Sid & Marty Krofft's biggest '60s and '70s hits, including "H.R. Pufnstuff," "Electra Woman and Dyna Girl," "Wonderbug" and "The Bugaloos."

"Looney Tunes Super Stars: Foghorn Leghorn & Friends â€" Barnyard Bigmouth" (Not rated, Warner Bros. \$19.98): Fourteen of the 15 remastered shorts on this collection have never been released on DVD and include Henry Hawk, Barnyard Dawg and the Goofy Gophers. Also out this week is a collection of previously released Tweety and Sylvester shorts called "Feline Fwenzy."

"Fantasia â€" Fantasia 2000" (Rated G, Disney, \$39.99/\$45.99): The Disney classics (albeit an edited version of "Fantasia") make it to Blu-ray. Of note: The Blu-ray version of this re-release includes "Destino," an early collaboration with surreal artist Salvador Dali.
